# Cinema Is Our Mission

Let us hypothesize: what if cinema were not (only) the mirror of reality, but its dream? We would thus find ourselves at the very origins of film and what it represents. The Lumière vs. Méliès dilemma. Although, upon closer observation, one could argue that the true visionaries were the Lumière brothers (the reinvention of reality) and the documentary filmmaker was Méliès (the live account of how the cinema-machine works). This tension is the infrastructure of the new edition of the Locarno Film Festival. We began to work on the entire range of the selection as soon as the curtain fell on the previous festival run. Film after film, we have pieced together a mosaic that reflects the multiple forms of contemporary cinema. Being aware that cinema as a form of art exists only as long as it has a dialogue with a wide audience, we have avoided the comfort of elitism, questioning ourselves once again as critics, programmers, and curators. And as spectators, always.

The previous edition's success is a known fact. Its films have enjoyed a tangible success in terms of audience, critics, and commercially, finding their natural outlet in theatres. Film festivals participate in an industrial discourse, of which Locarno is an integral part being Switzerland's largest film event - a position we claim and defend. In the service of auteur cinema, in all its forms, the competition features top-tier names.

From well-established film directors, such as Hong Sang-soo, Wang Bing, Ben Rivers, Pia Marais, Silvia Luzi and Luca Bellino, including Ala Eddine Slim, Gürçan Keltek and Kurdwin Ayub, Christoph Hochhäusler, the Zürcher brothers and Laurynas Bareiša, to Mar Coll and Sara Fgaier, Marta Mateus, Sylvie Ballyot, and Virgil Vernier, the competition is a deep immersion into the possibilities of contemporary film language.

An ambitious competition that consciously, critically, seeks a dialogue with the audience at a time in which both history and all its stories are imperiously knocking on the doors of cinema. Without ever giving up on pleasure. How to create a fruitful relationship with the audience and the adventurous viewer who commits their time to encounter the world? How to regain, once again, a space that is different from the relentless flow of news and from the images that cover the entire spectrum of contemporary communication? The names called to be part of this conversa-

tion to rethink our times are key artists in the development of present-day cinema. In the non-competitive sections too, artists like Edgar Pêra, Radu Jude, Bertrand Mandico, and Fabrice Du Welz, with their fresh approaches to the film-essay, or Marco Tullio Giordana and Isild Le Besco, with their cinema rooted in the abysmal depths of the unspoken in families and related traumas, are key elements of vital conversations.

Scrolling through the list of countries represented across the festival sections, we are met with a possibility of a world: another potential world. A polycentric world that is open to otherness and to one's neighbour, a curious, generous world.

In the spirit of Rossellini, we continue to believe that cinema means 'to work for humankind': to explore the forms of language that are still possible and to question the issues that run through us. Unique moments of pleasure shared in front of the world's largest screen. Encounters of communities who gather in front of a film as if around a bonfire to get warm with the pleasure of telling stories and being together as a society.

It is from the encounter that we think and build the future.

Therefore, a cinema in the present tense without ever giving in to the illusory comfort of nostalgia, as is the case with our retrospective dedicated to the 100th anniversary of Columbia, which plunges into the heart of a yet largely unexplored heritage and brings back to light all the glamour, fun, and novelty of a film production that has marked our way of thinking the moving images.

Happy cinema to everyone!

# A Festival of Limitless Possibilities

A cultural institution like ours is inevitably called upon to confront the world and its challenges head-on. Yet our specific historical moment makes that task a daunting one. The rapid changes of a complex global situation have provoked seismic shifts in every sphere of the film industry and raised serious questions about the role culture ought to play in society, as well as its modes of production, consumption, and financing.

At the Locarno Film Festival, we remain committed to the belief that, as a non-profit organization, we should be a place where the value of art is not reduced to its marketability as a product, nor to its power to entertain by merely distracting or reinforcing predetermined worldviews.

Cinema is the axis on which the various activities of the Festival must pivot. The core of the Locarno Film Festival will always be the films, which offer the public a remarkable selection of the finest examples of auteur cinema. But world-leading initiatives like Locarno Pro, the platform for industry professionals that acts as a meeting point for the European and international industry, or Locarno Edu and the Factory, two incubators for the talents of the future which encompass various educational programs as well as the Locarno Academy and BaseCamp, must also necessarily spin on that axis alongside the official selection.

This expanding of the borders of the traditional Festival model is a response to the changes in the world and a defense of our principles. Taken together, these initiatives bolster the idea of a vibrant cultural life, nurture all kinds of emerging talents, and promote positive developments within the industry.

For 11 days in August, Locarno transforms itself into a unique site of intensification - what an impressive concentration of relationships, of stimuli, of ideas! Dialogue and exchange rule the day, connecting different generations and providing the fertile soil from which the future of cinema can grow. The emerging talents that are absorbed into the Festival ecosystem via the Factory may later become part of the Festival's DNA, whether by showing their films in the program in future

editions, covering the Festival as writers, or participating in professional activities during Locarno Pro's Industry Days.

Locarno Edu shapes the audiences of tomorrow in an even more direct way, with educational screenings for our youngest viewers and their families that focus on curiosity and the spirit of adventurous discovery, giving to younger audiences a dazzling firsthand experience of cinema and promoting in them a nascent love of the visual arts.

As such, in the past few years we have witnessed a rejuvenation of the audience at the Locarno Film Festival: a new and enthusiastic generation of cinephiles attend its screenings, thanks in part to the organizational and strategic efforts we have enacted. The dual pillars of the Factory and Edu, developed together with our partners, have supported this expansion, providing a robust foundation for future activities and initiatives.

Even in the new course we're charting for the Festival, our organization will continue at every level to adapt to an ever-shifting landscape, listening with the utmost sensitivity to what is happening in the world and responding to it in turn. Ours is lately a world of collective regressions and frightening follies, but a generative structure like the Locarno Film Festival offers, in contrast, a message of hope.

We are aware that, in times like these, the ability to move in unison toward a single goal is in itself an extraordinary achievement. It is thanks to our audience comprised of the public, press, professionals as well as our valued partners with their tangible and intangible support that all this is made possible.

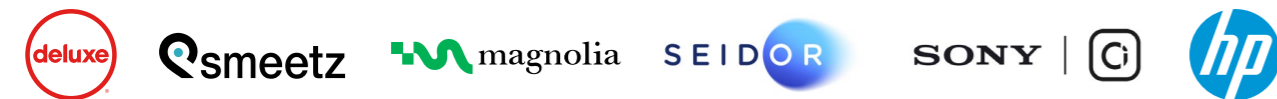

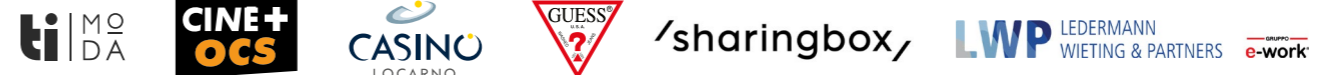

# PIAZZA GRANDE

Piazza Grande is what Locarno is all about. 8,000 seats. One of the largest screens in the world. Pristine projection. Booming sound. All of it outdoors, under the stars. Throughout the Festival, awards are given to special guests onstage at Piazza Grande: some of the most prominent directors, stars, producers, or technical wizards from the world of cinema take a bow before the audience. Then there's the program itself, which consists of some of the year's most anticipated films, coming to Locarno mostly in their world or international premieres. These are films everybody can enjoy, cinephiles, genre fans, and the general audience alike. But it doesn't stop there. On certain nights a second screening takes place just before midnight, giving space to either the films of the honorees, masterpieces from out of the past, or the true genre-bending oddities.

Since 2000, the **Prix du Public UBS**, the only official award of the Festival to be awarded by the Piazza Grande audience, has been presented to films that are destined to become part of film history. Starting this year, it will be joined by the **Letterboxd Piazza Grande Award**, given by a jury made up of Letterboxd editorial staff and young accredited critics attending the Festival to a new feature film showing on the Piazza Grande.

# RETRO- SPETTIVA

Few international festivals can claim the cultural significance of the Locarno Film Festival's famous retrospectives, which have long had a major impact on the worldwide conversation around the cinema of the past. Whether in its complete studies of major auteurs – offering the chance to absorb the complexities of a single filmmaker's artistic output in its entirety – or in canon-busting reconsiderations of national cinemas or film studios, the sprawling Retrospektiva is a beloved event for cinephiles, scholars, professionals, and the general public. And this year is no exception – with “The Lady with the Torch”, the Festival will counter the received wisdom around the legendary studio Columbia Pictures during its heyday from the sound era to the late 1950s, thus marking its centenary in 2024.

The Retrospektiva, curated by Ehsan Khoshbakht, is organized by the Locarno Film Festival in partnership with the Cinémathèque suisse. The Retrospektiva is made possible by the collaboration with Sony Pictures Entertainment.

# OPEN DOORS SCREENINGS

For more than two decades, the Locarno Film Festival has collaborated with the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) of the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA) on the section Open Doors, as part of Locarno Pro, whose mission is to support filmmakers from under-represented regions around the world, and from countries in which cinema as a form of expression is at risk. From 2022 to 2024, Open Doors has focused on the 22 countries across Latin America and the Caribbean and, throughout the year and during the Festival, carries out professional promotion and training programs during the Festival and year-round. Concomitantly, the non-competitive section Open Doors Screenings offers audiences in Locarno a selection of feature-length films and shorts that are representative of the region. In 2024, the spotlight is on all regions touched by the three-year cycle: Central America, the Caribbean, and South America.

# Locarno Pro: The Cornerstone of a Transforming Industry

Locarno Pro, the platform that welcomes more than 1,500 professionals to the Locarno Film Festival, is ready to address the most pressing issues of an industry with rapid and profound transformations at its doorstep. At the center of **StepIn**, our respected international think tank, a number of important issues related to artificial intelligence and the repercussions it will have on our entire ecosystem (both in the artistic sphere, with the use of generative tools, and in distribution, with potential consequences on the workflows of the entire production chain) will be addressed. With a keynote signed by Kelsey Farish (an intellectual property lawyer and expert on generative AI) and a selected panel discussion, we will delve into the opportunities and risks associated with the use of artificial systems. We will also look at the prospects for independent production in Europe, emphasizing alternatives to public funding and presenting new private funds for independent films.

After the success of the first year, we will return to organize a day dedicated to the heritage film industry, **Heritage Monday**, during which professionals will be able to (re)discover some masterpieces of the past in a newly restored form, as well as participate in discussions on the state of heritage film distribution and other networking events. On this occasion, we will present two films restored by the Locarno Film Festival thanks to the **Heritage Online** initiative and its **Contest**, sponsored by **Cinegrell: Mulher de Verdade** by Alberto Cavalcanti (Brazil, 1954) and **Samba Traoré** by Idrissa Ouédraogo (Burkina Faso, Switzerland, France, 1992), both in the official selection in the Histoire(s) du Cinéma – Heritage Online section.

Buoyed by the recent success of **Match Me!** alumnus Thomas Hakim, who produced Payal Kapadia's *All We Imagine as Light* (2024), winner of the Grand Prix at the Cannes Film Festival this year, Locarno Pro returns

to offer a wide and diverse roster of activities that serve as incubators for emerging talent: **First Look**, the showcase for films in the finalization stage, will have the spotlight on Spain for its 13th edition; **Match Me!** will welcome 36 new faces of independent production from 14 different countries; and **Alliance4Development**, the co-development platform for film projects from Austria, Germany, Italy, Switzerland, and France, will present 11 new projects during its ninth edition. Special attention will, as always, be paid to the young distribution professionals (one of the most fragile groups in our industry): in fact, 10 young professionals, including distributors, salespeople, festival organizers and experts in marketing, VOD, and film programming, will be welcomed inside the **Industry Academy**. Another 10 participants under the age of 30 will be integrated into the **U30** program, a think tank where the younger generation take the floor. With the Locarno Industry Academy and U30, we have succeeded over the years in creating a close-knit international community, thanks to the various events held throughout the year: a total of 11 industry academies and 2 U30 activities, in partnership with other festivals and events from almost all over the world. This year, to mark the Industry Academy's 10th anniversary, we will celebrate this community of young professionals more vigorously than ever, and those who cannot physically be in Locarno will still be able to access **Locarno Pro Online**, participating in our activities and accessing our content throughout the rest of the year.


Finally, the Locarno Pro team is delighted to celebrate 25 years of industry in Locarno together with partners and colleagues during the 77th Locarno Film Festival!

# Open Doors 2024: Toward Collaborative Industries

The third and final year of the **Open Doors** cycle on Latin America and the Caribbean is as thrilling as the previous two. This year's diverse array of countries brings a colorful delegation with vibrant stories across all three sections of the program.

For 3 years, mixing an online and in-person format has allowed us to expand Open Doors' offer and provided the opportunities for talents: connecting international collaborators and accessing resources as well as creative and professional inspiration to develop their projects and careers.

The film industry is not independent from global politics. On the contrary it is deeply connected with social and environmental issues. In this context, the need for collaboration among like-minded individuals for sustainable and diverse industries is more urgent than ever. Last year we explored our identities while this year we focus on how to unite these identities, enhancing creative and collaborative working structures, to develop and co-produce projects, aiming to create sustainable solutions.

This year's **Projects Hub** showcases a dynamic selection of young talents and fresh voices in storytelling, featuring eight exceptional projects from South and Central America and the Caribbean. These emerging talents will present their feature projects in development, blending genres, visions, history, and politics with social and human narratives in uniquely original ways.

In the **Producers Lab**, eight emerging creative producers and one junior producer will embark on a journey to foster regional collaborations and gain a global perspective on producing, all while supporting their directors in the creative process of development.

The **Directors Club**, launched in 2023, will welcome 17 directors presenting eight feature and nine short films in the Open Doors Screenings during the Festival. These films offer fresh perspectives on the cultural, political, and social landscapes of the focus regions.

Collective working methods will be discussed during the **Open Doors Talk** on Tuesday, August 13th, at an event open to the public. This session will highlight new perspectives on creative collaboration within and across regions.

Thanks to our long-standing relationship with the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) of the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA), and as part of Locarno Pro, Open Doors' activities run throughout the year, culminating in August in Locarno. We invite you to explore this year's program: the closing of our focus on Latin America and the Caribbean, and the opening of new paths.

## Premieres and Big Names for the Little Ones Too

Who said that great cinema doesn't really need to win over the little ones? This is a question that has been crucial for unforgettable filmmakers, who have dedicated some of their greatest masterpieces to child audiences. This year, on the evening of August 4, the Prefestival presented by la Mobiliare features a great classic like Steven Spielberg's *E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial* (1982), a film about the friendship between an alien and a group of children that has bewitched entire generations, iconically making bicycles take flight through the power of friendship and collaboration, in a message of hope essential for the times we live in.

And the magic doesn't end there. It continues with an exceptional award-winning Swiss animator: Claude Barras, filmmaker behind the celebrated *Ma vie de Courgette* (*My Life as a Zucchini*, 2016) and creator of extraordinary small worlds in stop-motion. He will collect the Locarno Kids Award la Mobiliare on the Piazza Grande and present his latest film, *Sauvages* (2024), a seductive journey into the heart of the Amazon rainforest seen through the eyes of a little girl taken from her native village, which becomes a struggle against those who are endangering the future of our planet.

Green themes come together in the **Locarno Kids Screenings** program, which, in addition to presenting a tribute to Barras, will offer a proposal for youngsters (and others) every afternoon at the Teatro Kursaal. It begins with Nino Pagot's *I fratelli Dinamite* (1949), a classic of Italian animation restored by the Cineteca di Milano, and will continue with a program full of new films. From Annecy comes the cute stop-motion film *Living Large* (2024) by the Czech Kristina Dufková, about the difficulties of a young boy who struggles to lose weight, while from Japan comes the long-awaited anime *KIMINOIRO* (*The Colors Within*, 2024) by Naoko Yamada (known for *A Silent Voice*, 2016), the story of the creative friendship of a group of teenagers. Also returning to Locarno is a master of French animation, Jean-François Laguionie, who will bring to Locarno his poetic journey into the desires of a family between the

postwar period and the present day: *Slocum et moi* (2024). Finally, three world premiere films recount the challenges of kids today: keeping real meeting places alive (in Klemen Dvornik's Slovenian *Igrišča ne damo* [*Block 5*], 2024); rescuing animals from places where they are mistreated (in Veit Helmer's German *Akiko, der fliegende Affe*, 2024); and keeping one's family and network of friendships together (in Patrice Sauvé's Canadian *La Petite et le vieux*, 2024). Plus, we'll close Locarno77 with a special screening on the Piazza Grande for families organized in collaboration with Cinemagia (ggl).

Rounding out Locarno Edu's offerings will be a series of workshops, meetings, and labs run by educational partners, starting with the renewed collaboration between the Festival and SUPSI's Department of Education and Learning for the **Movie&Media Labs**: a wide range of offerings for girls and boys ages 6 to 18. A range of educational and creative opportunities will also be offered thanks to valuable collaborations with Castellinaria Festival del cinema giovane, Filmkids, LACedu, RSI EDU, and WWF. There will also be "Behind the Scenes" events organized by Cinemagia (ggl) and cultural mediation workshops curated by the team of the Locarno Film Festival. Also among the happily returning programs will be that of the third Ticino edition of the **Atelier du Futur**. For the little ones, there will be the usual **Kids Corner**, while the Rotonda by la Mobiliare will offer a space for entertainment and hanging out for the whole family.

During the rest of the year, our engagement with the youngest audiences continues thanks to initiatives such as **La Giornata del Cinema**, the **Back to School** platform, and the various other collaborations with schools and cultural mediation institutes.

# The Factory is in Ferment

A movement that was initially almost imperceptible, but which year after year, edition after edition, has made its voice clearly heard amidst the bombastic roars of the Locarno Film Festival.

In truth, not one, but many voices - diverse in geographic origin, cultural background, and artistic sensibility - come together, from August 7 to 17, 2024 in the Locarno Factory.

There are many souls that make up the Factory: the artistic residency for young talents of **BaseCamp**; the Festival's personal training project for young filmmakers (**Filmmakers Academy**), for writers on film (**Critics Academy**), and for film industry professionals (**Industry Academy**); the educational experience of the **Documentary Summer School**; the review of films produced at film, television, and animation schools in Switzerland offered by **FILM FOUNDRY: Young Swiss Cinema**; and the **photography workshop**, which this year will be hosted by German photographer Sven Creutzmann. And then there are still all the projects that are active during the rest of the year, such as the **Spring Academy's** springtime film workshop, the **Locarno Residency's** accompanying pathway to a first feature film, and the **For the Future of Cinema and Audiovisual Arts** professorship at the Università della Svizzera Italiana.

*In Conversation We Trust* is the motto of the fifth edition of BaseCamp, a transdisciplinary artistic residency that hosts a selection of the finest emerging talents from Switzerland and the rest of the world in Locarno during the Festival. This slogan, however, is applicable to the entire Factory. Conversation is at the heart of its various projects, an open dialogue that is not restricted to cinema but stretches across the different artistic disciplines that meet in Locarno, leading to a fruitful creative contamination. It is a space that stands for freedom of speech and thought. It is able to break down cultural barriers, challenging and investigating social, political, scientific, economic, ecological, ethical, and other issues.

The Factory is a complex and lively laboratory, from whose confines the most current reflections on society and artistic creation spring to vivid life.

# FILM FOUNDRY: YOUNG SWISS CINEMA

3 days, 6 schools, 27 films, 1 horizon: the Cinema. FILM FOUNDRY: Young Swiss Cinema, a big screen event dedicated to the work of alumni and students from Swiss film schools.

This review of films produced by Swiss film, television, and animation schools is an event that has been an integral part of the Locarno Film Festival for twelve years. CISA has coordinated this event from the beginning, inviting Swiss universities and specialized professional schools to participate with a selection of their best short films, allowing for an exchange on their respective experiences of film production, in synergy with BaseCamp. Recent diploma short films from ZHdK Zurich, HSLU Lucerne, ECAL Lausanne, HEAD Geneva and CISA will be presented alongside a selection of film essays from USI Lugano and Mendrisio.

The **Zurich University of the Arts (ZHdK)** offers a bachelor program in which students experience filmmaking from conception to screening. The master program deepens the study and practice of fiction and documentary filmmaking, screenwriting, photography, editing, and creative production.

The **Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts (HSLU)** offers bachelor and master degree programs in animation and video. These programs focus on both animation and digital storytelling. The master program focuses on documentary film and experimental narrative forms.

The **École cantonale d'art de Lausanne (ECAL)** offers with its bachelor program an initiation into the various professions of filmmaking such as writing, directing, photography, sound, and post-production. The master program is aimed at developing a personal cinematic vision with a focus on fiction cinema.

The **Geneva University of Art and Design (HEAD)** offers a bachelor program aimed at exploring the diversity of film writing between documentary and fiction. The master program is focused on documentary cinema. ECAL and HEAD have created their master programs in partnership with one another.

The **Università della Svizzera italiana (USI)** has initiated a course on how to film architecture and inaugurated, in collaboration with the Locarno Film Festival, a Chair titled Future of Cinema and the Audiovisual Arts.

The **International Academy of Audiovisual Sciences (CISA)** of Locarno is a Higher Specialized School with a two-year program culminating in the diploma of Visual Designer, which is followed by a one-year specialization program with five majors (in directing, cinematography, sound, editing, creative production) that lead to the federal post-diploma qualification in filmmaking and television.

From July 31 to August 17, the Rotonda by la Mobiliare will once again be a place for exchange and dialogue, while also providing the nightly entertainment at Locarno77 with a packed program of concerts, performances, art, and culinary experiences. Each evening from 6 PM, the Rotonda, collaboratively envisioned by the Locarno Film Festival and la Mobiliare and designed by atelier oï, is the place to be in Locarno for music lovers of all ages, a free-to-access arena for chill moments, culinary delights, activities for kids and families, live DJ sets and concerts, and for great conversations shared with friends and loved ones.

## A Place for New Memories

In the run up to Locarno77, the Rotonda by la Mobiliare is the premiere destination for families and adults from the region, hosting a slate of artists and vendors whose presence and entertainment offerings will help build expectation for the region's biggest cultural event of the year. ## What's the Line-Up?

Some highlights of the line-up, conceived by the Locarno Film Festival and la Mobiliare, will include **La Rappresentante di Lista**, who will take the stage, followed by a DJ set by **DJ Drago**, in a special event co-presented by Rolling Stone Italia on August 2.

The musical line-up for the weekend of August 9 and 10 will be curated by RSI Radiotelevisione svizzera. It will start on Friday with a concert by **Dom Lampa** and his overwhelming energy, a journey through distant rhythms, reggae sounds and Brazilian roots music. This

will be followed by a performance by charismatic Swiss singer, songwriter and composer **Bastian Baker**, who will bring to the stage - with his guitar - folk songs with an engaging melody. On Saturday, August 10, stage to Italian singer-songwriter **Ermal Meta**, who will perform hits from his repertoire and songs from his latest album *Buona Fortuna*.

This year will also feature **DJ Damante**, **Gianluca Grignani**, **Le Vibrazioni**, **Jay-K**, and the **Golden Vultures** - more names will be announced later in July. An eclectic line-up overall, reflecting the Rotonda's commitment to remaining a space for all tastes and interests.

On August 1, la Rotonda will host a fundraising charity event to benefit the populations affected by storm that violently hit Vallemaggia in early July. The event will feature leading musicians from Ticino, who will take turns performing on stage from 4 PM to midnight.

In addition to the main acts, the music program - supported also by Stiftung Phonoproduzierende, Swissperform, enjoyArena, and riser., and Radio Ticino - will include a wealth of supporting artists who will keep the show going through all hours of the night, while the unplugged concert stage will host rising artists from all over Switzerland, thanks to the support of Mx3.

Also back for the second year in a row is the **Club**, a space with underground charm that is open every day until late at night, where after hours you can continue to enjoy DJ sets and entertainment.

# Gender Evaluation

The gender of direction was calculated based on the SWAN (Swiss Women’s Audiovisual Network) method that defines 4 categories (woman, man, non–binary, and mixed direction). A fifth category was added to include the “prefers not to disclose” choice.

The five genders of direction taken into consideration are the following:

Woman = the director identifies as a woman.

Man = the director identifies as a man.

Non–binary = the director identifies as non–binary.

Not disclosed = the director’s gender was not disclosed.

Mixed direction = the directors identify heterogeneously as female, male, non–binary, or not disclosed.

# SUSTAIN- ABILITY AT LOCARNO77

We are firmly committed to recognizing the importance of mitigating our negative impacts on the environment and promoting environmental sustainability. We have taken significant steps in order to calculate our greenhouse gas emissions (direct and indirect) to understand the full environmental impact of our activities.

Calculating our carbon footprint provides us with a solid foundation on which to build a comprehensive environmental and climate strategy aimed at reducing emissions, minimizing waste, and promoting sustainable practices.

## OUR STRATEGY FOR DECARBONISATION:

- **Understand our greenhouse gas emissions:** the reality of a film festival is complex and defies any standard. We quantified all direct and indirect emissions associated with our activities, including energy consumption, assembly processes, transportation and other relevant sources.

- **Identify critical areas:** we are in the process of identifying the critical areas that contribute most to our carbon footprint. This step is critical to prioritising effective emissions reduction efforts.

- **Set reduction targets toward net zero:** based on our GHG inventory, we are laying the foundation for an emissions reduction plan. Our goal is to achieve net zero CO<sub>2</sub>e emissions by 2050, in alignment with key national and international guidelines and collective efforts to address climate change. This is an ongoing journey that requires the commitment and participation of our employees, suppliers, partners, and audience.

We are committed to maintaining the highest standards of environmental responsibility: the study currently in development, the results of which will be published during 2024, will conform to the principles and requirements outlined in the international standard ISO 14064-1, with the support of Positive Organizations, the Festival's Impact Partner. The latter provides a robust framework for quantifying and reporting GHG emissions, ensuring transparency, accuracy, and consistency.

## RENEWABLE ENERGY USAGE

Screenings in the Piazza Grande, Europe's largest open-air cinema, and all other venues are powered by 100% renewable energy thanks to our partnership with SES.

We encourage employees, guests, and the public to choose environmentally friendly means of transport. We have established strategic partnerships with SBB/CFF/FFS, Autopostale, Ego Movement, and more.

## PET BOTTLES

We have significantly reduced the number of PET bottles used in the official venues (a 50% decrease) and, thanks to the City of Locarno, the public will find fountains with fresh drinking water around the venues to refill their water bottles.

## SUSTAINABLE CATERING

We have decreased the availability of meat-based food options by 50% versus 2023 in favour of plant-based offerings. Additionally, we prioritise products from local, organic producers to reduce the carbon footprint associated with transport.

## ECO-FRIENDLY MATERIALS

We are committed to producing merchandise made from recycled or sustainable materials. Our official bags are made from organic cotton and our iconic lanyards are made from R-Pet.

## DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

We have launched an enhanced mobile version of our website to ensure a seamless digital experience and reduced the print run of our publications by -33% versus 2023.

## WASTE REDUCTION

We provide waste separation bins at all official Festival venues, donate leftover materials to the Fondazione Diamante who make handmade products, and collaborate with Too Good To Go to ensure that leftovers from all official events are made available to the public.

# DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION POLICY

We are committed to ensuring that our Festival is diverse, inclusive, and accessible to everyone, regardless of race, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, gender, age, ability, or religion. The Festival Center is located in the Palazzo della Sopracenerina, an important historical building of the 19th century. In its courtyard, under a beautiful skylight built by world-renowned Swiss architect Mario Botta, you will find a small cafe and the Press Desk. Here you can pick up your accreditation as well as your welcome bag and your copy of the official catalogue. The Press Desk provides help with questions, requests for materials, press kits, and will also support you by submitting requests for interviews with Festival guests.

### PRESS VILLAGE

This year, the Press Village will be located on the first floor of the Palazzo della Sopracenerina (above the Festival Center). Here, in the large hall, embellished with frescos and large windows overlooking the Piazza Grande, which was used as the press center during the Locarno Treaties of 1925, journalists and information operators will be able to follow Photocalls and Press Conferences. Also, its strategic position allows one to reach the Teatro Kursaal, PalaCinema, and, of course, Piazza Grande in just a few steps.

#### • Press Conferences

Press Conferences with delegations from all the films presented in the Concorso Internazionale and shown in Piazza Grande will be held every day in the Conference Room of the Press Village.

#### • Photocalls

Photocalls with delegations of the films presented in the Concorso Internazionale and shown in Piazza Grande, will be held at the Press Village, and are accessible to accredited photographers only.

### PRESS SCREENINGS

Press screenings of the Concorso Internazionale, Concorso Cineasti del Presente, and Piazza Grande are accessible for both accredited press and industry. Priority access is given to the press in case the cinema reaches capacity. All the press screenings will take place at the Teatro Kursaal (Largo Zorzi 1, 6600 Locarno), except for the screenings from the Concorso Cineasti del Presente which will take place at the PalaCinema 3 Leopard Club (Piazza Remo Rossi 1, 6600 Locarno).

Please note that film reviews (print, web, radio, TV, social media, and any other media) about world and international premieres are subject to an embargo and can only be published 30 minutes after the start of the public screenings at the Locarno Film Festival. There is no embargo for general coverage of the Festival.

### DIGITAL LIBRARY

The Digital Library is a secure and exclusive platform accessible to accredited press and industry professionals, offering the convenient opportunity to watch online part of the titles featured in the Official Selection and parallel sections of the Locarno Film Festival (the availability is based on permission granted by the rights holders).

Films of the Pardi di Domani section and Open Doors Screenings are available on the Digital Library as of August 6 at 3.30 pm. Films in the Fuori Concorso section and premieres presented in the Locarno Kids Screenings section are available on the platform starting 24 hours before the first public screening at the Festival.

Films in the Piazza Grande, Concorso Internazionale, Concorso Cineasti del Presente, Panorama Suisse, and Semaine de la Critique sections are available from the end of their first public screening at the Festival.

All films will be available, unless otherwise indicated, until August 31, 2024.

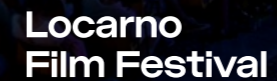
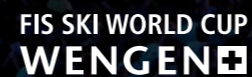

### PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN TICINO

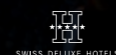

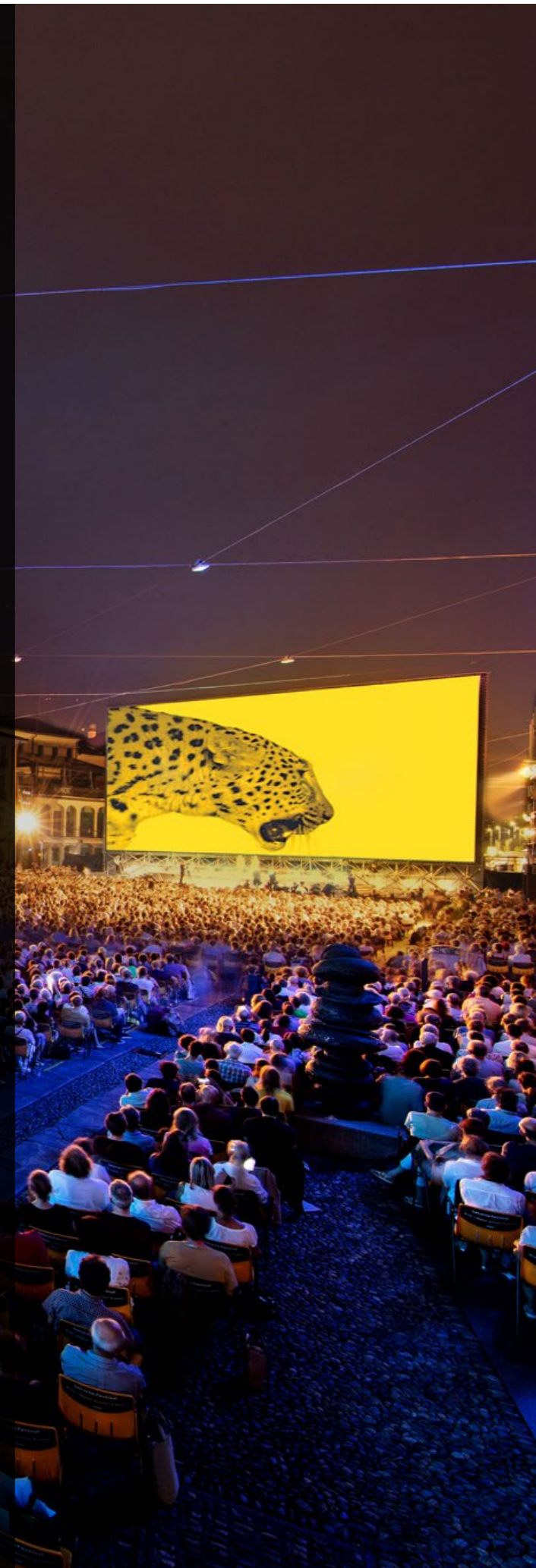

## Swisscom promotes community experiences

**All the way back in 1946**, in the wake of World War II, a group of cinema enthusiasts launched the first edition of the Locarno Film Festival, immediately finding attentive ears and the full support of the association that dealt with the city's tourism promotion at that time, happy to have the opportunity to take a gamble on an event that would – perhaps! – be the driving force behind a renaissance in tourism and the economy, spreading the word about little Locarno on the national and international stage. So many years later, we can fully appreciate just how **far-sighted those pioneers were**: the Locarno Film Festival has now become not only **one of the world's biggest auteur cinema events**, but also a fundamental factor behind the cultural and economic growth of the entire region.

The Festival actually anticipated so-called “major event tourism” by many years, which, in the meantime, has become an integral part of our way of life. **The Ascona-Locarno region, which boasts long-staging and major events, is constantly reinventing itself and attracting new partnerships** that further expand what is already a varied and high-quality offering. ## The Cinémathèque suisse at the Locarno Film Festival

Press release, Lausanne, July 10th, 2024

**An unmissable annual event, the Locarno Film Festival is renewing its collaboration with the Cinémathèque suisse, which is contributing two recently restored Swiss films this summer and lending several prints from its collections.**

Presented in competition in 1983, Marcel Schüpbach's *L'Allègement* (*The Unburdening*) will be screened as part of the "Histoire(s) du Cinéma - Cinéma Suisse Redécouvert" section, alongside Michel Soutter's *Repérages* (*Faces of Love*, 1977) starring Jean-Louis Trintignant, who died two years ago and to whom the Cinémathèque suisse paid tribute last year. Both films have been digitally restored with the support of Memoriav, and RTS for Michel Soutter's film.

### Columbia Pictures retrospective

Partnering once again with the festival's retrospective, dedicated this year to the 100th anniversary of Columbia Pictures, the Cinémathèque suisse will also be paying tribute to the legendary Hollywood production company in its cinemas in September, with subsequent screenings at the Filmpodium Zurich, the Rex in Bern and other European institutions such as the Danish Film Institute (Copenhagen), the Filmoteca Española (Madrid), the Arsenal (Berlin), the Filmhaus Nürnberg and Eye Filmmuseum (Amsterdam).

Cinémathèque suisse's Research and Archive Centre at Penthaz is also making a number of rare prints available for the festival's 35mm screenings. These include one film by Steven Spielberg, the Italian version of *E.T.* (1982) for the Prefestival evening in the Piazza Grande, as well as Jane Campion's *An Angel at My Table* (1990), winner of the Pardo d'Onore Manor 2024 award and the subject of a complete retrospective of her films in Lausanne, to be screened at the Capitole cinema beginning in September.

### 3rd OPEN AIR LOCARNO FILM FESTIVAL AT PLATEFORME 10

From 16 to 21 July 2024, the esplanade of PLATEFORME 10 will be transformed into Lausanne's "Piazza Piccola" for the 3rd edition of its open-air cinema, organized in cooperation with the Locarno Film Festival, Switzerland's largest film festival. Selected by Giona A. Nazzaro, the Festival's artistic director, this year's lineup mixes some Piazza Grande hits of 2023 ("Anatomy of a Fall", "The Old Oak") with a choice from other sections. Nazzaro's 2024 selection is a perfect representation of Locarno's trademark diversity: a unique mix of films that have thrilled the Piazza Grande, from "Anatomy of a Fall" to "The Old Oak" and "La Voie Royale", by Swiss director Frédéric Mermoud, as well as new discoveries and rare gems such as "Ricardo et la Peinture", by legendary director Barbet Schroeder.

### New in 2024: An Evening on Surrealism and a joint promotion for students

This 3rd edition will be marked by several special events. The 3 museums of PLATEFORME 10, MCBA (fine arts), mudac (design) and Photo Elysée are currently celebrating the 100 years of surrealism with 3 exhibitions. The surrealists loved to play with different art forms, from painting to photography. They were also among the first to understand the strength and creativity of cinema. To celebrate this, a special evening is devoted to surrealism in this year's selection with the screening of 2 films by *the enfant terrible* of French cinema, director Quentin Dupieux.

Finally, the collaboration between the Locarno Film Festival and PLATEFORME 10 is expanding with a special student competition that will give young film goers the chance to spend a week in Locarno during the 2024 edition. Lausanne belongs to Switzerland's most important student cities and regions, with among others UNIL or EPFL, a world top 50 science and tech university.
